

TRAFFIC & PARKING INFORMATION - LUBEC

Saturday, June 27 - Heavy Traffic on Rt. 189, Bridge, Border Crossings, School
Expect delays and avoid the bridge if possible

For safety reasons due to the large volume of traffic and runners on the road the following restrictions have been approved for the weekend by the Lubec Board of Selectmen:

Sunday, June 28 - 700 Runners on roads, various parking and traffic restrictions in place. Plan ahead and stay off the roads if possible.

Washington Street / Route 189	7:30am - 8:30am	One lane southbound only. Northbound use Main, School & Pleasant
Pleasant Street	8:45am - 9:15am 10:45am - 11:45am	Closed to vehicles
Commercial & Monument Street	8:45am - 9:15am 9:45am - 11:45am	Access only
Main, School, Summer Streets between Pleasant and Water Streets	4:00am - 3:00pm	Closed to vehicles
Water Street	4:00am - 3:00pm	Closed to vehicles
Roosevelt Memorial Bridge	7:00am - 1:30pm	One lane traffic - delays

Pleasant Street (from Commercial to Washington)	4:00am – 12:00pm
Summer St between Pleasant Street & Water Street	4:00am – 2:00pm

Main Street between Pleasant Street & Water Street	4:00am – 2:00pm
Main Street – north side – (park on south side only)	4:00am – 2:00pm
Main Street between Flatiron Corner & School Street (Emergency Route)	4:00am – 2:00pm

TRAFFIC INFORMATION CAMPOBELLO

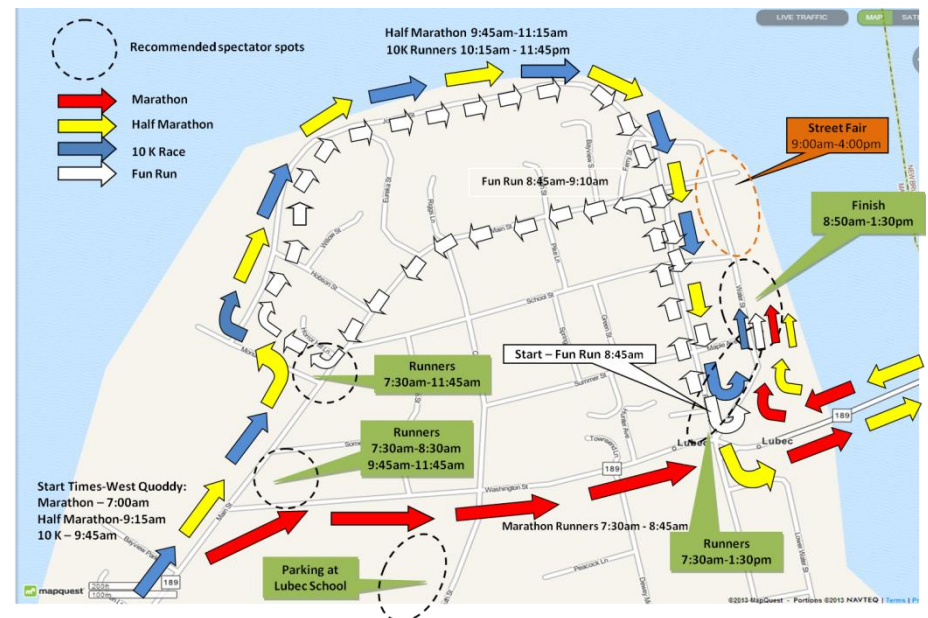
Saturday, June 27 - Heavy Traffic on Bridge and Rt. 774 between Bridge and Herring Cove Park. Expect delays and avoid the bridge if at all possible

Sunday, June 28 - Plan ahead and stay off the roads if possible. Pick a spot and stay there for the day. Good places to park and watch are listed on the front page. **If you have friends or family in the race, please DO NOT follow or leap-frog them - they will be disqualified.**

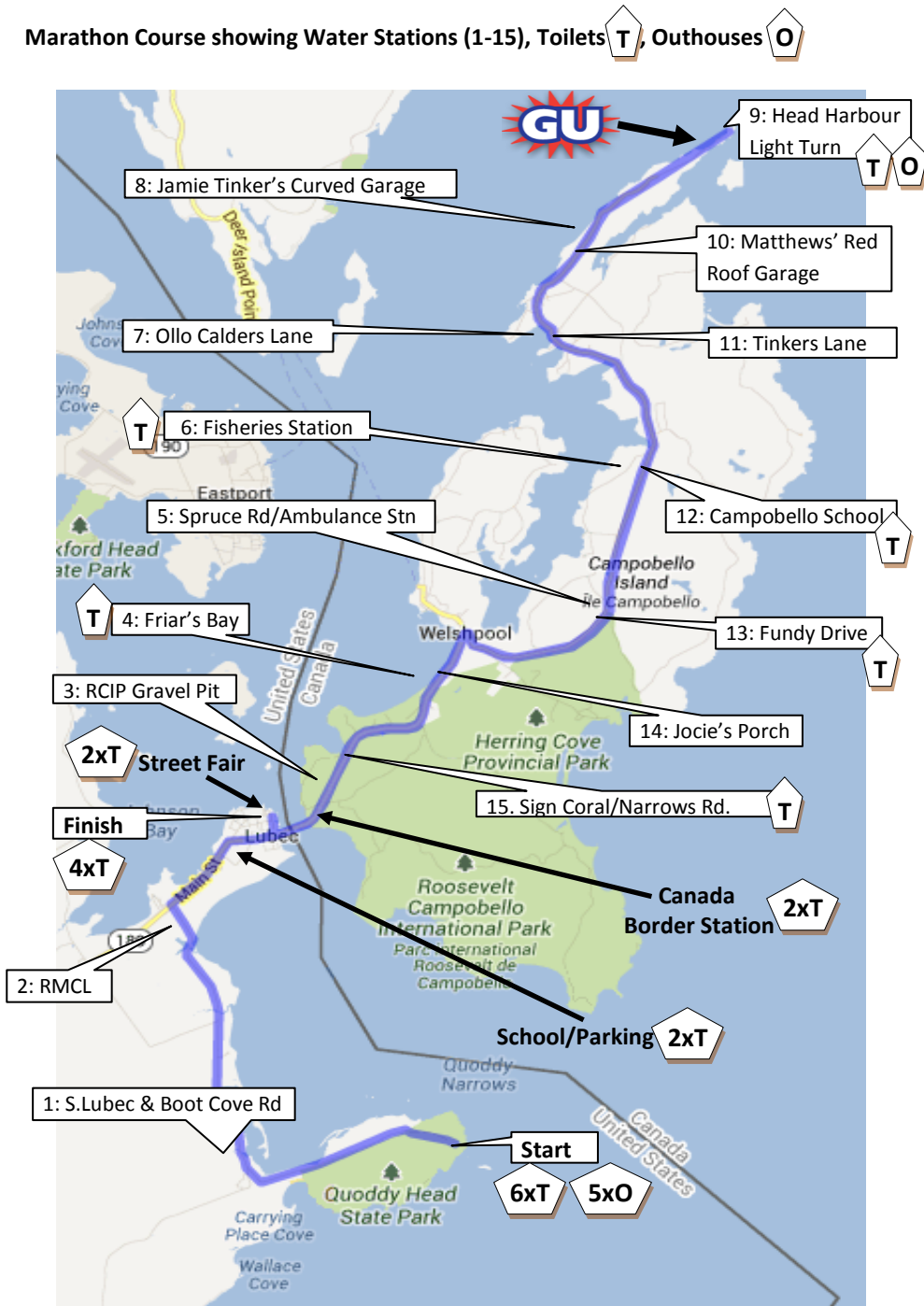
Runners will be on the following roads:

Roosevelt Memorial Bridge	8:00am - 2:30pm	One lane traffic - delays
Route 774 between Bridge & Crossroads	8.30am – 2:30pm	Very slow traffic – runners on both sides of road and some turning back at crossroads (2 races)
Rt. 774 Crossroads to Head Harbour	9:00am- 1:45pm	Slow traffic – runners on both sides of roads (1 race)
Lighthouse Road	10.00am - 12.30pm	Very slow traffic – please avoid totally if at all possible
