4. To obtain a Maine Dept. of Transportation road opening permit prior to excavating in State roadway limits, and to abide by all requirements of said permit.
5. To cooperate at all times with the Town of Lubec - and its representatives and to allow the Town or its representative to inspect the internal plumbing within the building at any reasonable time.
